- 15 July Daniel went to Niskayuna depot to pick up a man named Edwin Collins "to set up the business of canning green peas for winter use."
"A woman came for information; she stayed all night. We thought she was not prepared to be a Shaker and informed her so and she went her way."
- 17 July Sisters all begin shelling peas and getting a beginning made towards putting them up.
- 18 July "A strange lady came here and said she wanted to stay here a few days so . She appears quite singular. Her name is Hannah Langdon."
- 19 July "The woman that came last night is a Jew. She is keeping the Sabbath and is fasting and reading the Bible. She has not been out of her room today." Sat
- 20 July "Another woman came here who wishes information about our religion. She appears to have some concern about her soul, but as it rained so hard we could not have meeting, she stayed here through the day and all night. Name is Helena Gibson, from Staten Island. She was taken to SF. Hannah Langdon taken to Albany." Sun.
- 29 July Francis Thayer has concluded to go to his mother and Margery Mathews is going to her grandmother.
- 12th Aug Brethren and sisters begin shelling peas. Collins is going the canning.
- 16 Aug Woman named Clute drowned in Mohawk while batheing.
- 18 Aug In a.m. a man and two women came. Said they were from Long Island. This afternoon about 4 p.m. another man came "in pursuit of them. He did not state the cause of his coming."
- 3 Sept Collins comes to run canner to put up succotash.
- 4 Sept Having trouble with succotash - cans bursting and leaking./
"A good many people are around today to see the Shakers."
- 8 Sept Collins canning peas, succotash and plums.
"The washing was done in the afternoon and a great day's work beside."
- 11 Sept Went to Adam's land - Green Island - to get pennyroyal.
- 18 Sept. Man and woman brought one girl and 2 boys to stay on trial.
- 23 Sept Collins came to can tomatoes. Did 40 bushels.
- 24 Sept Maria Finch made up her mind to go to her aunt in Albany.
- 25 Sept Take little girls out to collect herbs.
- 29 Sept The DeWitt woman came and Ophelia decided to go home with her to stay.
- 2 Oct Collins canning corn and beans and continues with corn & tomatoes.
