Now have no speaker so usually DABuckingham reads to them. 25 Aug 92 doz. cans tomatoes canned today. 31 Aug Sisters work on tomatoes in a.m.; in p.m. they cut 14 barrels of apples to dry. 10 Sept Brother John Robe came to speak at public meeting. Excellent. 15 Sept "All hands commence the work at the canning house in good spirits but few in number." 17 Sept The Crandell woman came and took her boys home with her. 20 Sept Elder Giles Avery spoke at the public meeting. 22 Sept "Mrs. Pruyn, son of Judge Parker's daughter and her sister, brought as their guests Lord 26 Sept Russels son and his wife, a daughter of one of the Lords." Finish canning for the present. 28 Sept Canning tomatoes again. 80 doz. today. 4 Oct Go to Albany to meet group from Groveland who have been visiting in Lebanon. They 12 Oct are Henry Cantrell, Justin Bud&ne, Laura Dole, Lavinia Dutcher & Polly Lee. After public meeting, General Sheridan and Col. Schuyler Crosby called and six from 13 Oct South America, some of whom could not speak one word of English. Nearly all the family came and shook hands with them.
