

Ann Buckingham - 1837

18 Sept Stanton goes to Durup to work on broomcorn.

22 Sept Some sisters gather liverwort.

Oct. Generally gathering winter apples, digging potatoes. Cutting apples (for drying & cider).

2 Oct Stanton goes to Durup as usual.

6 Oct Brethren finish broomcorn to Durup and to the river.

14 Oct Jennet Angus takes job as physician.

21 Oct Fred comes out as Elder; Stanton goes in.

4 Nov Governor visits.

Nov. Generally making cider, boiling cider and coloring.

15 Nov Fred fixing NW room in Brick Shop to make pipes in.

17 Nov "I am trying to make a few baskets to sell."

30 Nov JH is building a pipe kiln.

12 Dec "Elder Brother & Stanton, Elder Sister & Polly goes to the South Family to attend to the visions."

15 Dec "MB, LP, AA, LFu, AM and I goes to the Second Family (WF) to see the visions."

19 Dec Eunice and I begin to cut some caps.

29 Dec We finish the caps - 2 fine ones apiece for the sisters.  
I am determined to be more faithful  
In this year which is now begun  
That I may gain a heavenly treasure  
Which will fit me for the world to come.

13 Jan ZS (Zeviah Spier) comes out of physician's lot and Caroline D. goes in. Lucy Fairchild goes to Office to take CD's place.

17 Jan Betsy Carter died <sup>aged 54-7-2</sup> ("took her flight to the world of spirits").

25 Jan "Nothing new except the Devil has been seen."

15 Apr Three of Legislators to Shaker meeting.

2 Apr Bathsheba Shays died. <sup>aged 57</sup>

4 Apr "The bonnet fever runs very high."

5 Apr Jane Leonard's mother comes to see her with 3 men to take her.

12 Apr Sarah Fairchild <sup>aged 37</sup> died on 11th. ("struck with death")

2 May Loisa Fairchild at NF has broken her ankle.
