- 30 Apr "Cold & rainy, very humbly disagreeable weather."
- 10 May Sisters lay out cotton cloth to whiten.
- 18 May "Great day among us. Moriah Gillet & Abby M. resigned their commission among the girls and come into the meeting room to live. Jennet Angus & Matilda Wells take their place. Lucy Fuller took Jennet's place in physician's line & Elizabeth took Lucy's at the washhouse. Nancy White went to the Office kitchen to work and that is not all. Mercy Harwood & Caroline Downs went in the North Chamber to live and Almira T. & Ephraim P. went down into the meeting room to live. Some more Sylvester P. went into the North Chamber to live."
- 20 May Sisters wash the cotton cloth.
- 29 May Brethren wash sheep.
- 31 May Three boys came to CF Christopher Smith, Nehemiah  $S^{\prime\prime\prime}$  and John  $S^{\prime\prime\prime}$
- 1 June Brethren shear sheep.
- 14 June Willard Allen began to card, Elizabeth T. & Sarah Ogden to comb, Eunice J., Desire H., Betsy H., Elizabeth S. to coloring blue.
- 20 (Sun) Arrived from PLeasant Hill, Eldresss Anna A., Elder Brother Edmond, Micajah Burnett & a young sister Sarah Jane McBride.
- 7 July Morrell Baker & DAB go to Ballston after herbs.
- 8 July Brethren in general turn out to raise a barn at WF.
- 14 July "Something of a tumult among the bogtrotters to the river."
- 19 July Greatest part of brethren are haying at River# Farm.
- 20 July Few brethren left at home spend time fighting fire.
- 7 Aug Sarah Ogden's mother came to see her with a constable and a young man to take her. (In the following weeks, Sarah's case was in court, with the elders going to Albany, but Sarah continuing her regular life with the Shakers.)
- 21 Aug One dozen of draw baskets made for sale (by herself-PAB).
- 27 Aug River farmhouse is cleared out of all furniture for Laban Hill to move into.
