6 Mar "Great stir among the indwellers of the Church; there is a union meeting established in the garret against Elder Brother's room and also in the brethren's porch."
Barnet & Abraham Hummel came here to live.
18 Mar FSwicker, Freegift & Eld Bro Jos. Hodgson went to Albany "to attend a memorial on behalf of the Society."
24 Mar Barnet Hummel has decided to go to his mother.
27 Mar Elizabeth Seely has made 18 bonnets for home use.
28 Mar "I finish 4 doz. baskets for sale & 6 for home use."
1 Apr "Eld Bro has finished the lye leach and Daniel has placed it south of the ashhouse."
