- 9 Emeline Ellen Ward and a girl came to reel their silk.
- 11 Thos. Dudley came to help CM - that makes 9 hired men here.
"SB and CC both stay home (remarkable)."
- 12 Sun. "After the world was dismissed, the ministry went & stayed with
our ministry through a meeting. All attended our meeting in p.m.
After the meeting was nearly through, Elder Bro gave Joseph
T---- liberty to speak what he felt. Accordingly all under 20
years seated themselves on the floor around him, the rest of
the assembly on the seats, when he spoke very feelingly to the
young."
- 14 SB took very broom available to Waterford.
- 17 At Pleasant Hill have harvested 1000 sheaves spring wheat, ✓
2800 of rye, 4000 of oats, 40 bu. barley. Also 240 bu. oats
on River Farm.
- 24 CC about 4:30 went looking for group who had gone berrying.
He could not find anything of them for a long time; they came
home at 10 p.m.
Got a box of swifts from Hancock.
- 25 Four men came, had dinner and went to school. "They all had some
high office, I believe."
Hayden Treadway came, had dinner, bought \$25 of seeds, herbs,
baskets, etc.
The brethren let SF have 4 tons of hay from River Farm.
