- "Willard concluded to go, the fire grew so hot. SB took him to Albany. Brother & 2 sisters went to Hoosick to take Sarah Simons to find a home for her. Back on 26th.
- The Ayers boys brought back the things they stole from the mill.
- 28 Finished harvesting broom corn--90 loads.
- 2 Oct Harriet Ingham came to see her children.
- In Albany bought some chairs for new house on Island.
- 4 "SB began hosuekeeping at Pleasant Hill in the forlorn building, Tom & George sleep there."
