- 21 Sab. "This is the day we fast and pray. We attend to the gift the same as usual of late years."
- 23 CC went with Tom (Walde) to look for a team for him; they came home with one poor little black thing with one eye..  
Charlotte Youngs came with a cousin; stopped a short time.
- 2 Nov Martin & Dennis Brainard left to look for a place to work this winter. They have worked for us ever since they came to this country.
- 6 J. Whitehead, her step-father, came to see Jane Leonard and wanted her to go to live with her mother near Utica and she concluded to go.
- 7 CC took Jane and her step-father to Schenectady to take the train and took the "antirenter horse" along and sold him.  
Charles H. Rosier let it be known that he had made up his mind to leave; went with SB to Albany, "then took the cars east to go to mama as soon as possible."  
Thomas Edwards returned from NY this morning, came to see the boys and came again in the afternoon and informed the Elders he was leaving and taking the boys with him.
- 8 Richard Dean came with Thomas Edwards, the boys had their things packed "even to the old quilt," left about 11 a.m. "Thus one more family is extinguished among Shakers."
- 12 Rain, rain. Visit Island and found water almost up to new house. Witbeck folks went and secured the scow or it would have been lost. Also they went on the Island and swam off some of the Shaker cattle. One of the steers swam down river a mile below Vischers Ferry and finally made it to shore. They put him in a stable, blanketed and rubbed him down and let Shakers know where he was.

- 13 DAB went to the SF for Ransom Guilford who is to live in this family.
- 16 A man came with a load of poke root and CV lent CM \$7.75 to pay for it.
- 19 Did the two east chambers (in Office) with pink composition, the walls never had anything done to them before.
- 21 Took their cloth to Lebanon "to be pressed."
- 24 CC got some flag carpeting: "a little damaged" for dining room.
- 26 Two brothers went after pipe stems near Fonda.  
Luther Wells came to help Frederick cut some coats.
- 28 CC got 25 lbs. feathers for ministry and 15 lbs. of cotton twine for family. Judge Parker, wife & 3 children came, had dinner, bought a cheese for \$4.50.
