- 20 Picking currants. "It seems as though we should be burnt up" hot, no rain.
- Last of the currants about 25 bushels.

 Ministry decided to expose him but not to imprison him.)
- 24 Rained most of the day "all exceedingly thankful."
- 25 FSw went to Troy with Elder Issachar & Geo. Peavy to see the spiritualists again about Henry Hanson.

 CM went to Mechanicville to order a lot of "light stripe"(material)sent to Pleasant Hill.
- 28CM & Daniel went to look for some kinds of herbs & also looked at some land for sale at Rosendale.
- 29 CC & CM went to look at the land for sale.
- 1 Aug Philip (?) began to make brooms.
- 8 CC & CM went to see about the land, met at the SF's West Farm with Asa & Alexander "as they are determined to have a part or all of it."
- 11 CM went about one mile beyond Schenectady & got 1500 broom handles.
- Daniel went after more handles got 2000.
